## Rooms



Relax in the comfort and privacy of your warm and inviting guest suite.

On each of the Twin XL beds, you'll find cozy linens provided, so you can enjoy a pleasant and restful nights sleep. Each room also comes furnished with a bedside table, Shabbos lamp, hamper, and Negel Vaaser.

With central heating and cooling, and complimentary **high-speed Wi-Fi** available throughout the premises, we hope to make your stay an enjoyable and memorable one.



The Lodge has 21 bedrooms, with 54 XL Twin beds:

- 14 2-bed en-suite rooms.
- 2 2-bed rooms with bathrooms nearby.
- 4 en-suite rooms with 2 bunk-beds.
- 1 en-suite room with 3 bunk-beds.
- 12 Pack-and-Play cribs with linens.

Complimentary high-speed Wi-Fi at the Hakhel Lodge allows you to stay in touch with contacts in the city and remain connected to the internet.



# Commercial Kosher Kitchen

The Hakhel Lodge features a fully-equipped Meat Kitchen with commercial-grade appliances and amenities. In addition to a walk-in fridge and freezer, the kitchen is equipped with oven space for up to twenty eight 9×13 trays, and a stovetop with ten burners. A variety of pots, oven trays, kitchen utensils, and knives are available for use.



## Dining Room

Experience dinner with a view of the towering forest behind the Hakhel Lodge. Coming with a crowd? The Dining Room at the Hakhel Lodge offers comfortable seating for 60, and 4 deluxe solid wood tables that you can configure to your own liking. Take advantage of the 10 infant high-chairs for your convenience, and the buffet for self-service meals.



## Full-Service Tableware

The Hakhel Lodge offers Meat tableware for up to 60 guests, including flatware, glasses, dinnerware, and serving dishes. Enjoy serving your Shabbos meals on exquisite vegan leather tablecloths and restaurant-grade tableware, which can be cleaned in the industrial dishwashers after Shabbos.





# Shabbos Amenities

The Lodge is fully supplied with all your Shabbos necessities. Find for your convenience: Shabbos candles, Kiddush cups, washing cups, challah boards and knives, challah covers, laminated kiddush cards, bentchers, Havdalah supplies, and more. In addition, the kitchen and breakfast bar are equipped with a 64-cup hot water urn, a large cholent crock pot, and 2 electric hot-plates.



## Dairy Kitchen

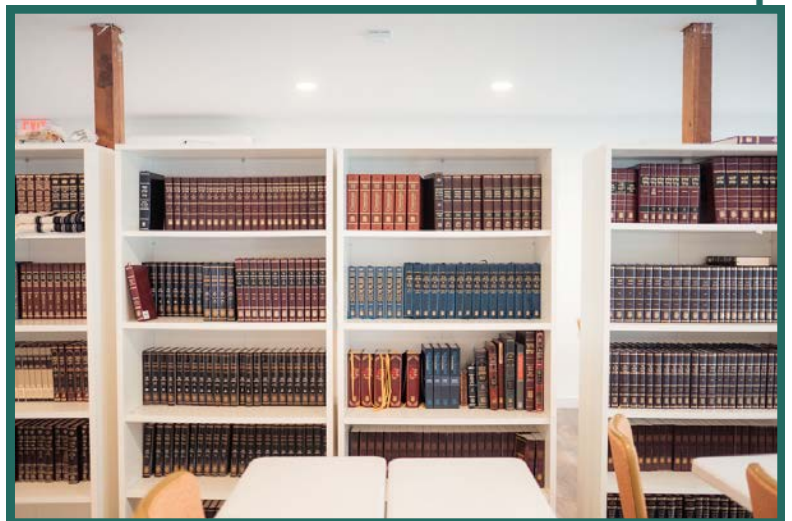
For dairy meals, the dairy kitchen is equipped with its own fridge, oven, stove, and sink. The dairy kitchen is also stocked with cooking utensils including two electric waffle makers and two Betty Crocker Pizza Makers so you can prep your meals with ease.

*Note that dairy foods must be served on disposable utensils.*



## On-site Shul

The Hakhel Lodge Shul is fully stocked with everything needed to hold minyanim, including Siddurim (Nusach Ari), Chumashim, and even a Sefer Torah. With separate entrances for men and women, and gorgeous windows overlooking Coldbrook Creek, the shul comfortably seats 50 and includes a fantastic library of Hebrew and English sefarim.





## Lounge

For relaxing, shmoozing, or those late night conversations, the Lounge offers an inviting and comfortable space with sofa seating for 20. Cuddle up under the cozy couch blankets and take advantage of the provided logs to light the fireplace. Sit back and enjoy the warmth and sensation of a cackling fire, perfect for roasting marshmallows!

## Coffee Bar

The Coffee Bar is equipped with a mini fridge for conveniently storing milk and creamers, a 60 cup urn, and washing sinks. The coffee station also features a space to store hot cups and lids, as well as tea and coffee. *Note that no dairy utensils can leave the dairy kitchen. Dairy foods must be served on disposable utensils.*



## BBQ Pit

For the cold night – or the warm one, pull up a chair and a guitar and gather ‘round the campfire... or in this case, the Breeo, which does double-duty as a fire-pit BBQ. Perfect for a S’more snack (Parve of course, the BBQ is fully Fleishig) or cooking dinner for the whole group.

*Guests should be aware that outdoor quiet hours must be observed from 9pm-7am.*



## Wading Creek

Ideal for those long summer days, or a lazy Shabbos afternoon, the Coldbrook Creek runs across the perimeter of the Hakhel Lodge. A great sunny spot sits just below the Look Road Bridge, where the boulders make a fun climb down to the refreshing water. Coldbrook Creek is about 4 feet deep at its deepest point, which is perfect for both little kids and grown-ups.

*\*Disclaimer: Extra caution must be taken in and around the creek. Children must remain supervised at all times.*



## Outdoor Eating

Looking for a change of scenery? Move your lunch- or your dinner- outdoors! The Hakhel Lodge outdoor seating area boasts 6 canopied picnic tables, overlooking the creek. Each table can comfortably seat 8 and is situated close to the BBQ pit. Enjoy your meal surrounded by the natural beauty of the environment, from the sound of the creek's rushing water, and the wildflowers that grow aplenty.

## Car Charging Station

Park your car outside the Shul, plug-in, and fully charge using the complimentary Tesla charging station. If you choose to bring along an adapter, you can charge your electric vehicle as well.
